Release Notes for PlanetPress EnvelopeNOW 1.1.5

The following is a list of last minute issues, features and documentation notes.

Changes from 1.1.4

- 2422: The Code 39's WAS now behaves as intended when used in duplex mode.
- 2517: Conflicts between PlanetPress Suite 7.3.x and EnvelopeNOW have been resolved.

Changes from 1.1.3

- Installing Service Pack 1 for Windows 7 or Windows Server 2008 R2 no longer deactivates the application.

Changes from 1.1.2

- DI500/600 now has correct WAS sequence. You may have to recreate your project for changes to be effective.
- The bitmap image of the inserter is now stored properly in the project file
- List of preferred configurations is now displayed properly

Known Issues

- When capturing jobs from the PlanetPress printer driver, the resulting PDF and Meta files may not always be deleted after processing. You can perform a manual cleanup of the *My Documents\PlanetPress EnvelopeNOW\DataCapture* folder to delete the remaining files
- On the DI900/950, barcodes stamped on Landscape documents may get rotated at print time.
